### **How often may I play golf without paying green fees?**

Each membership is entitled to play TWO rounds and enjoy complimentary green fees, at each participating club, every thirty days. When traveling to Cleveland, for example, a couple from Seabrook Island Club with Signature Gold could play Firestone Country Club on Tuesday, Silver Lake Country Club on Wednesday and Quail Hollow Country Club on Thursday and only pay for cart fees at each club. ### **How far in advance can I make tee times?**

### **What is the definition of complimentary meals at the business clubs?**

### **If I am a Non-resident Member living in Atlanta, may I use the private clubs in Atlanta?**

No, sorry, but Signature Gold is a traveling benefit and is not meant to bypass membership at clubs located in the communities where you reside.

### **How will charges be handled when visiting a Club?**

All charges will be paid at time of service with a major credit card.

### **What is the price for adding Signature Gold Unlimited to my membership?**

The enrollment fee is \$5,000 and the required monthly dues are \$50 a month. However, ClubCorp and your Board has agreed to waive the enrollment fee through March 31<sup>st</sup>. Members enrolling may simply pay the monthly dues to begin. After that time, the fee will apply. New Members enrolling will also be allowed to enroll without paying the \$5,000 fee.

### **May a Member resign from Signature Gold?**

Yes, by communicating to your club's membership office. It is a month to month membership. There is little risk in enrolling and trying the Signature Gold benefits and enjoying the free green fees and dining. However, if a Member resigns from Signature Gold, and then wishes to reinstate the benefits, the \$5,000 enrollment fee will apply.

### **What is the protocol to enroll new Members?**

Members will complete a one page enrollment form. This form will be sent to The ClubLine so they have a record of the new Member. Usually, Signature Gold benefits may be enjoyed within 48 hours of enrolling. The Signature Gold Unlimited card will take 2 to 3 weeks and will be sent to the club for distribution to the Members.

**How many tee times, each day, is the participating golf club required to make available to other Members with Signature Gold traveling to the area?**

Two tee times daily, one in the morning and one in the afternoon. Clubs may take more if they choose, but are not required to take more than two. Therefore, Members with Signature Gold are limited to reserving no more than two tee times “back to back”.
